

TERMS OF ACCEPTANCE FOR EMPTIED PACKAGING

- The packaging must be empty.
- For safety and legal reasons and to prevent problems during handling and transport, the packaging must be closed with the original closure system(s).
- Product labels with hazardous material information must conform to the last filled product and must not be removed or made illegible.
- MSDS must be provided by the generator upon request.
- Packaging that last contained toxic, highly irritating, odorous or proven CMR (carcinogenic, mutagenic and reprotoxic) products or products that could cause health and/or safety problems during their handling and processing must be decontaminated.
- Decontaminated packaging must be marked and supplied with a dated certificate.
- DRUMDRUM can offer a proposal for the decontamination of some hazardous materials upon request.
- DRUMDRUM cannot accept packaging used for radioactive substances, explosives, gasses, infectious products or asbestos.
- Packaging emptied of products that contain PFAS must be notified in advance to DRUMDRUM by the manufacturer via <u>collections@drumdrum.eu</u>, so DRUMDRUM can propose the appropriate treatment.
- The generator is responsible to ensure that the packaging is ready for collection and meets the collection conditions. Should a packaging fail to meet one of the collection conditions, DRUMDRUM is entitled to refuse to accept the package(s) and/or charge the generator for costs incurred.
- The /generator is responsible for the correct and complete loading of the packaging into the truck, trailer or swap bodies. There should not be any product on the outside of the packaging, so that it can be transported without contaminating the truck. If this is not the case, the costs for cleaning of the vehicle will be charged. Packaging must be loaded with the closures facing upwards. Drums loaded on pallets need to be attached to each other using strap band, stretch wrap or duct tape.
- The number of the collected packaging and the grading of the packaging will be determined at unloading at DRUMDRUM or its subcontractors. These numbers and grading are binding. Indication of the number of packaging on the shipment documents is only indicative.
- Transport documents (e.g. bill of lading) will be provided by DRUMDRUM or its subcontractors. The generator is responsible for checking the transport document and refilling them where necessary.
- DRUMDRUM takes over the responsibility for the packaging that meets the acceptance conditions during sorting/processing at DRUMDRUM or at the subcontractors. The generator remains responsible and owner for packaging that does not meet the acceptance conditions.
- By accepting these terms and conditions and by using the DRUMDRUM for the collection of emptied packaging, the generator agrees to pay for all costs incurred in relation to non-compliant packaging.
